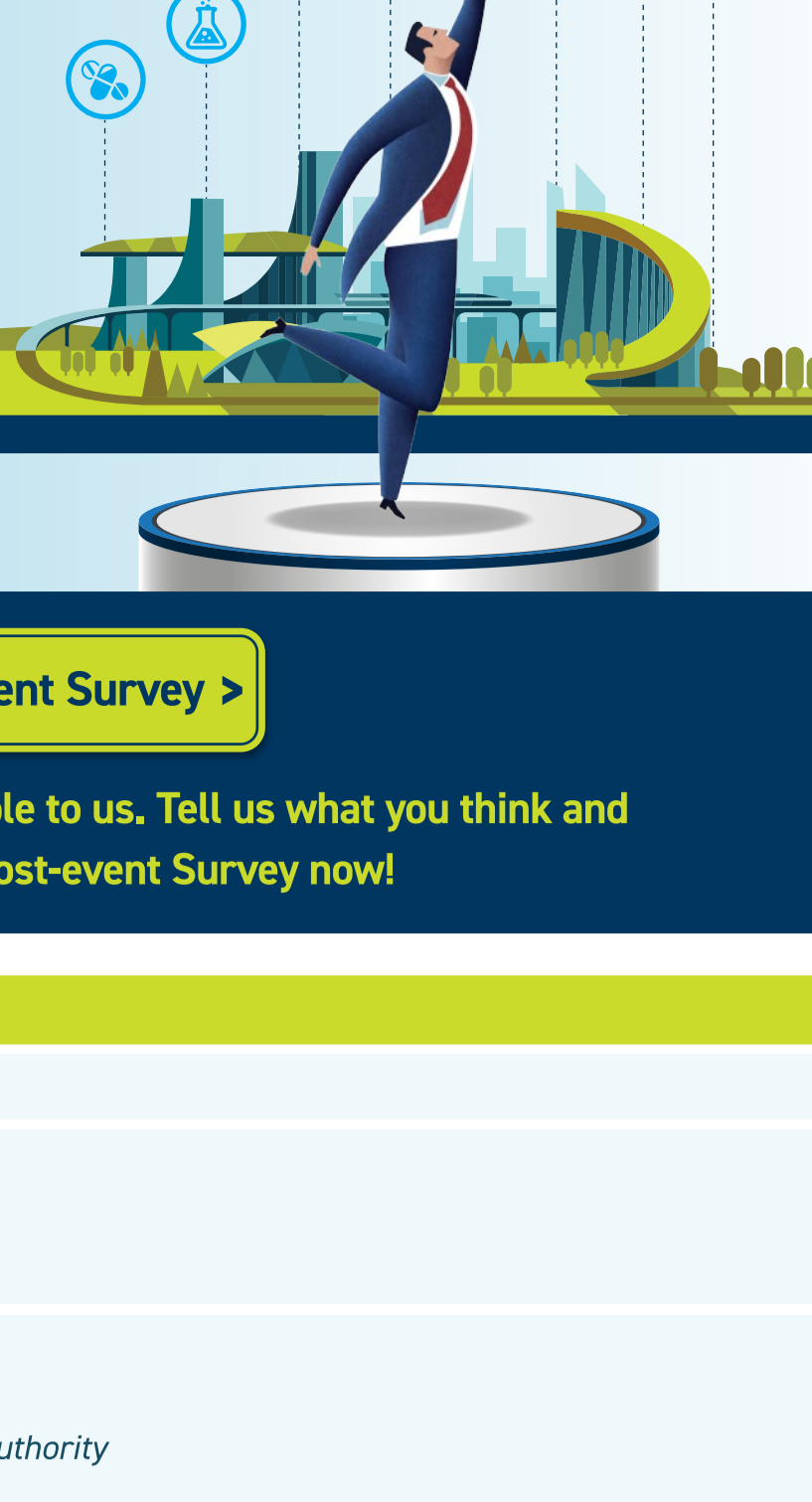

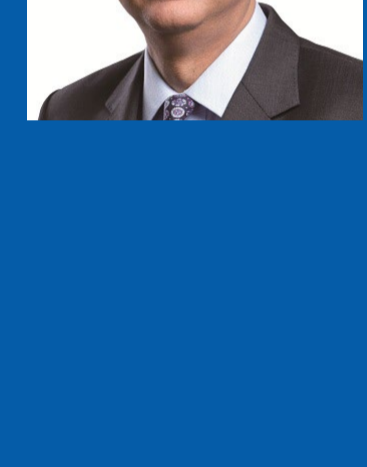

Vice Chairman of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) Business Advisory Council and Chairman of its Task Force on Banking and Finance, Chairman of the Permanent Commission on Economic and Financial Issues of World Union of Small and Medium Enterprises (WUSME), Honorary Chairman - Asia Pacific of CMA Australia, Chairman of Monte Jade Science and Technology Association of Hong Kong and President of Hong Kong-ASEAN Economic Cooperation Foundation. Earlier he also served as a part-time member of the Central Policy Unit, and a member of the Task Force on Industry Facilitation under the Digital 21 Strategy Advisory Committee, the Assessment Panel of the Small Entrepreneur Research Assistance Programme under the Innovation and Technology Fund, the New Business Committee of the Hong Kong Financial Services Development Council and the Legal Aid Services Council.

 Dr. Moses Cheng is a Consultant of Messrs. P. C. Woo & Co., one of the longest established law firms in Hong Kong, after serving as its Senior Partner from 1994 to 2015. He is also admitted to practice as a solicitor in England and Wales, the State of Victoria in Australia and Singapore, and is a member of the Hong Kong Society of Notaries as well as a Council member of the Association of China-Appointed Attending Officers. Over the years, Dr. Cheng served in many public roles including the Chairmanship of the Council and Court of Hong Kong Baptist University, the Education Commission, the Board of Education and the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong. He was also an independent non-executive director of the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited and an appointed member of the Legislative Council between 1991 and 1995. Presently, Dr. Cheng is an independent non-executive director of a number of listed companies. Apart from being the Chairman of the Insurance Authority and the Process Review Panel for the Securities and Futures Commission, he is the Chancellor of the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui (the Anglican Church of Hong Kong). In recognition of his many services and contributions to Hong Kong, Dr. Cheng was awarded the OBE by Her Majesty the Queen of the United Kingdom in 1994, the Gold Bauhinia Star by the HKSAR Government in 2003, and the Grand Bauhinia Medal in 2016. Dr. Cheng has also been conferred honorary doctoral degrees by a number of local universities.

 Mr Lamba is the Co-Head of the Market Development Division at HKEX Group, which is responsible for the development and implementation of major new HKEX initiatives, and includes the functions of product development, project management and issuer, client and marketing services across all asset classes.

Prior to joining HKEX, Mr Lamba was a Senior Advisor to JP Morgan's Asia Investment Banking and Capital Markets business, with strategic and operating responsibilities from 2008. He has also worked at Merrill Lynch Asia Pacific for eight years as a Managing Director, where he led the firm's regional Energy and Power investment banking group and served as the Chief Operating Officer of the firm's China Origin business. At Merrill Lynch, Mr Lamba led several landmark listings of Mainland enterprises in Hong Kong. Prior to moving to Hong Kong in 1994, Mr Lamba worked in the financial services industry in the US for nine years. Mr Lamba holds Master of Business Administration and Bachelor of Science in Economics degrees from The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania in the US.

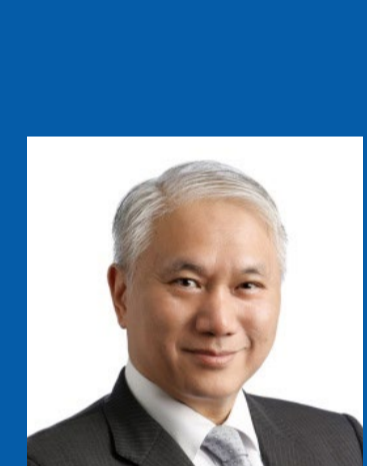

 Charles graduated from Purdue University in the United States with his Bachelor and Master degrees of Science in Computer and Electrical Engineering.

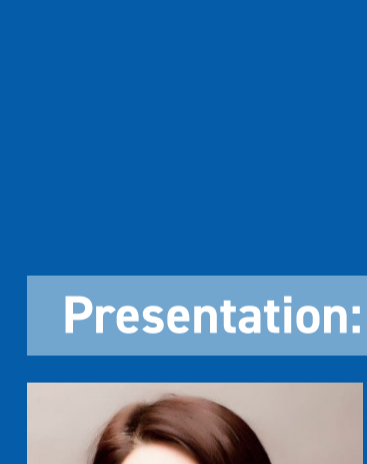

 In 2016, Timothy was named to the Forbes Asia's 30 under 30 list.

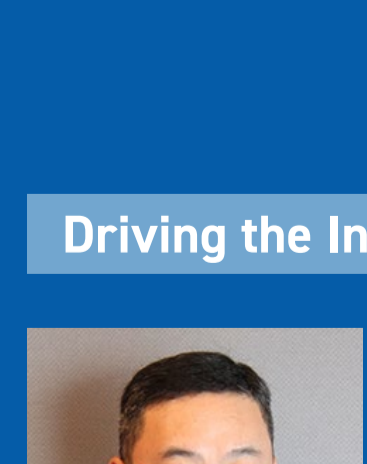

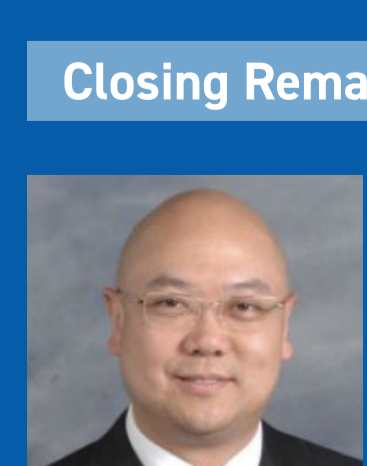
