Cyberport Career Fair 2022 Opens for Three Consecutive days

Hong Kong, 4 June 2022 – The three-day (from 4 June to 6 June) Cyberport Career Fair 2022 kicked off today. Officiating at the ceremony were Mr Bernard Chan, Convenor of the Non-official Members of the Executive Council of the HKSAR Government, Mr Alfred Sit, the Secretary for Innovation and Technology of the HKSAR Government, Mr Simon Chan, Chairman of Cyberport and Mr Eric Chan, Chief Public Mission Officer of Cyberport. This year, the online Career Fair has gathered more than 150 enterprises, offering over 1,500 job opportunities in different areas, including FinTech, Smart Living, Digital Entertainment, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Big Data, Blockchain, and Cybersecurity for I&T talents via a virtual interactive platform with elements of the Metaverse. People interested in the I&T sector can give full play to their abilities by exploring an ideal job at the Career Fair.

Mr Alfred Sit, Secretary for Innovation and Technology of the Hong Kong SAR Government, in his opening remarks for the career fair, said, "The Cyberport Career Fair has been a signature match-making event for our community companies and innovation and technology talents, fulfilling Cyberport's public mission of talent cultivation. Pursuing your path in innovation and entrepreneurship is bright and promising. The National 14th Five-Year Plan expresses clear support for Hong Kong to develop into an international innovation and technology hub. The Government has introduced a series of measures and policies to support the healthy and sustainable development of innovation and technology. On infrastructure, we have Cyberport expansion project, a San Tin Technopole comprising the Hong Kong-Shenzhen Innovation and Technology Park in the Lok Ma Chau Loop and the areas nearby, building landmark I&T facilities with a scale comparable to Cyberport in Lau Fau Shan, etc. We are confident that these initiatives would bring our innovation and technology sector and our younger generation to chart new heights in the months and years to come."

Mr Simon Chan, Chairman of Cyberport said, "Cyberport is committed to nurturing and promoting I&T industry to the youth, by hosting the annual Cyberport Career Fair, we aim to provide a matching platform for enterprises and aspiring youth. With the accelerated digital transformation of the society in the post-pandemic era, the demand for I&T talents in various industries has been increasing. This year's Cyberport Career Fair is offering a record high of over 1,500 I&T job openings, I look forward to the fruitful results of the Fair, to bring in new blood for the industry, and provide opportunities for young people who are interested in the I&T sector to seize the golden age of I&T development in Hong Kong."





Mr Bernard Chan, Convenor of the Non-official Members of the Executive Council, said, "The global trend of innovation and technology is opening up tremendous opportunities for creative and talented young people to pursue a career in innovation and technology. With the accelerated digital transformation of society in the post-epidemic era, emerging concepts such as Metaverse and ArtTech have prevailed. The demand for technology talents from various sectors continues to be strong. The National 14th Five-Year Plan clearly stated that the Central Government supports Hong Kong's development into an international innovation and technology hub and an East-meets-West Centre for International Cultural Exchange. Young people should grasp the opportunity of innovative technologies and creative industry development under the support of national policies. I hope that the new-term Government will formulate a comprehensive and effective youth policy and blueprints, helping the youth to unleash their potential and fulfil their dreams. We are embarking on a golden age of innovation and technology. I call on more young people to kick-start their career in the innovation and technology industry with courage and put Hong Kong innovation on the map with enthusiasm."

Participating organisations include large corporations and Cyberport start-ups, covering FinTech, Virtual Insurance, Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain, Education Technology, Ecommerce, Medical Healthcare, and Digital Entertainment etc. To enrich job seekers' understanding of recruitment trends of the industry, Cyberport will organise more than 50 career forums and recruitment seminars to discuss popular trends in innovation. Speakers from Meta, Animoca Brands, PwC, Hong Kong Designers Association etc, will share views on hot topics in I&T such as "Riding ESG Wave & Green Finance", "Metaverse Task Force Assemble", "Women Entrepreneurship & Business Opportunity in GBA Development", "Looking into the Future of Work, Workforce & Workplace", "Future Skills & Future Living", "Nurturing Future Tech Talents from Global to Hong Kong", etc.

This year, Cyberport further enhanced the user interface of the Career Fair 2022, adding a "3D effect" experience and using the "Kumospace", a long-distance social networking portal to create a real-life experience and enable virtual interaction for participants. In addition, to help job-seekers better prepare themselves for job hunting, there will be human resources specialists providing free resume consultation services. At the same time, in conjunction with Cyberport start-up Datality Lab, a free Artificial Intelligence analysis and interview assessment have been added to provide job seekers with a professional interview improvement report. The online job-matching platform will remain open until 3rd July to allow continued matching between employers and job seekers.
