Digital Entertainment Leadership Forum 2023 Officially Kicks Off Today

Exploring New Developments in Web3 and Creating a New Future for Digital Entertainment

Hong Kong, 25 August, 2023 – The Digital Entertainment Leadership Forum (DELF) 2023, an annual event organised by Cyberport, officially commenced today at Cyberport. The ceremony was officiated by esteemed guests including Mr Paul Chan Mo-po, Financial Secretary of the HKSAR Government; Professor Sun Dong, Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry of the HKSAR Government, Mr Zhang Zhihua, Director General of the Youth Department of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government in the HKSAR; Mr Simon Chan, Chairman of Cyberport and Mr Peter Yan, CEO of Cyberport.

Visitors will have the opportunity to engage with numerous innovative and unique experiential activities, including Metaverse catwalk fashion show powered by Cyberport's community startup Ubivox and Vivienne Tam, Heart Resonance, an AI-driven immersive art installation, painting experience of the HTC VIVE VR Solutions crossover Hong Kong's renowned Aurora Painter Bernard Wong, blockchain-based platform Moxy.io - eSPORTS FOR ALL, and Drone Soccer, Sportopia and more, providing visitors with an amazing experience to immerse themselves in extraordinary digital entertainment creations from various domains.

The Financial Secretary also officiated the opening of the Web3 Living Lab. Web3 Living Lab provides a platform for entreprises to showcase their solutions and applications, and for community members to learn and collaborate together. Web3 Living Lab supports the application and adoption of Web3 technologies, promotes business innovation, brings the Web3 community together for knowledge sharing and experimentation, and raises public awareness of Web3 development.

The spotlight event will be the "Sport and Art Tainment Carnival" and AIIT AI In-place Triathlon Alpha Grand and the 6th Projection Mapping Festival will be hosted tomorrow. The final day will showcase an array of exciting competitions, including the Elderly e-Sports Tournament & Experience Day by Rotary Hong Kong, ER Marvel Snappers Assemble, HKGD Game Competition & Expo 2023, and the Smart LOHAS Walking Football Experience Day. Various workshops and experience zones will remain open until Sunday, offering the public a comprehensive opportunity to immerse themselves in the joy of digital entertainment!
