## **Cyberport Career Fair 2026 Offers Over 2,000 Career Opportunities** *Exploring 21 Fast-Growing Tech Sectors and Their Emerging Career Horizons*

**Hong Kong, 12 March 2026** - Cyberport Career Fair 2026 will be held on 20 and 21 March under the theme “Set Sail Towards Your Digital Future”. The event will provide more than 2,000 innovation and technology (I&T) positions. Participants will gain comprehensive insights into career prospects across 21 fast-growing I&T sectors, including artificial intelligence (AI), big data, and the low-altitude economy. For the first time, the event brings immersive interactive experiences that put cutting-edge tech directly in participants’ hands, such as Baidu Apollo’s autonomous driving introduction and drone football competitions. Representatives from iFlyTek will share insights into the skill sets that the Chinese Mainland enterprises expect from Hong Kong youth. In addition, an Info Day and on-site interviews of the “3TRIP Internship Programme” will take place, offering opportunities for young people to pursue careers in the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and the Chinese Mainland. The event aims to provide participants with comprehensive support to access employment information in the I&T industry and to equip themselves for future opportunities, helping strengthen Hong Kong’s I&T talent pool, and contributing to the nation’s strategies of advancing “AI+” and building a smart economy new model.

This year’s Career Fair brings together I&T enterprises offering over 2,000 job positions, underscoring a strong demand for I&T talent. With new quality productive forces such as AI, big data, and cybersecurity rapidly reshaping global industries, the Career Fair’s new interactive elements will enable participants to experience frontier technologies firsthand, deepen their understanding of emerging I&T areas, and spark their interest in joining the I&T ecosystem. Cyberport will continue to drive talent development, align corporate needs with the talent pool, and support Hong Kong in becoming a hub for I&T talent. These efforts will advance Hong Kong’s goal of establishing itself as an international I&T hub and lay a solid foundation for the smart economy growth.”

### **First-Ever Autonomous Driving Showcase and Drone Football Interaction**

This year’s Career Fair focuses on AI-related interactive elements, enabling participants to experience cutting-edge technologies and gain insights into I&T advancements and career opportunities. Baidu Apollo’s autonomous driving introduction will provide close-up insights into smart mobility ecosystems. Drone football competitions and interactive sessions will highlight low-altitude economy applications, giving participants a deeper understanding of job roles and talent demand in Hong Kong’s emerging drone industry.

The Career Fair aims to connect participants with the Chinese Mainland career opportunities. iFlytek, a leading provider of AI speech technologies, will share insights into the key skills that Chinese Mainland enterprises expect from Hong Kong youth, enhancing their competitiveness in the Chinese Mainland job market. Meanwhile, an information day and on-site interviews of the “3TRIP Internship Programme” will take place, offering internships in the Mainland cities such as Beijing and Shanghai. This provides young people who aspire to pursue a career in the Mainland with direct access to practical roles and career pathways.

### **Comprehensive AI Job-Seeking Experience**

Over the two-day event, there will be more than ten seminars and workshops covering topics such as AI, EdTech, youth entrepreneurship, animation and gaming industry, career planning, and more, which will help participants grasp the latest industry trends and skill requirements. In addition, participants will benefit from a comprehensive AI-powered job-seeking service, including AI Job Interview Assessment simulations, CV Clinic analysis, and AI CV Photography services. An AI career-matching platform will also be available, using deep data analysis across 57 data points to compare job seekers’ profiles with 2,000 positions, providing participants with highly accurate recommendations.
