Cyberport Community Clinches 36 Honours at Hong Kong ICT Awards 2024

Achieving record-breaking results with the new distinguished AI accolade

Hong Kong, 22 November 2024 – The Cyberport community has once again demonstrated its excellence at the "Hong Kong ICT Awards". This year, 31 start-ups clinched a record-breaking 36 awards across all eight categories, including two Grand Awards, seven Gold Awards, nine Silver Awards and more. To foster the innovative use of artificial intelligence (AI), a new distinguished accolade, the "Best Use of AI" award, was established for each category. Cyberport community members **Bridge AI**, **FCC Analytics** and **Vizzle** earned this special AI award in the "Smart People", "FinTech" and "Digital Entertainment" categories respectively.

Ir. Eric Chan, Chief Public Mission Officer of Cyberport, said, "The Cyberport start-up community shone through at the Hong Kong ICT Awards 2024, achieving record-breaking results by clinching 36 awards across all eight categories plus the new AI accolades. This fully demonstrates our excellent achievements in the field of innovation and technology (I&T) and our efforts in promoting the development of the AI ecosystem in Hong Kong. As Hong Kong's digital technology flagship and AI hub, Cyberport will launch the largest AI Supercomputing Centre in Hong Kong within the year. This initiative aims to enhance Hong Kong's research capabilities across various industries and to build a complete AI ecosystem centred around computing power, models, and model risk assessment, industry application support, governance, and ethical discussions. Cyberport has currently gathered over 330 companies specialised in AI, big data, and robotics to promote AI innovation and applications, driving the intelligent transformation of various industries through AI empowerment. Going forward, Cyberport will continue its efforts to cultivate start-ups and facilitate their proactive integration into the national development, promoting Hong Kong as an international I&T centre."

Three Community Members Win Newly Established "Best Use of AI" Award

As one of the three major technology clusters at Cyberport, the influence of AI is growing. This year's ICT Awards has established a new accolade called the "Best Use of AI" award for each category, and Cyberport start-up community members **Bridge AI**, **FCC Analytics** and **Vizzle** won this special award in the "Smart People", "FinTech" and "Digital Entertainment" categories respectively. **Bridge AI** in a partnership with Lenovo Group has established Hong Kong's first AI Hub to support students with special educational needs, also won the "Smart People (Smart Empowerment) Gold Award". **FCC Analytics**, a regulatory technology (RegTech) company that provides AI-powered end-to-end anti-money laundering compliance solutions, won the "FinTech (RegTech) Gold Award" by using Federated Learning technology for anti-money laundering activities in the financial industry. **Vizzle**, one-stop SaaS solutions for both online and offline events by blending AI and XR technologies, also garnered "Digital Entertainment (Interaction Design) Gold Award".

Cyberport Start-ups Capture 19 Awards in FinTech and Digital Entertainment Categories

Cyberport, as the city's leading FinTech hub, is home to the biggest FinTech community in Hong Kong. Its Cyberport start-up community won eight awards in the "FinTech" category, including a Grand Award, two Gold Awards, two Silver Awards and one Bronze Award on top of the "Best Use of AI" award mentioned above. **Evident**, one of the participants of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority's wholesale central bank digital currency, Project Ensemble Sandbox, in the "Green and Sustainable Finance" area, won the "FinTech Grand Award" and "FinTech: Banking, Investment and Insurance) Gold Award" for its licensed investment platform for alternative assets. **RD Holdings (Hong Kong) Limited** won the "Fintech (Emerging Solutions) Silver Award" thanks to its licensed stored value facility in Hong Kong: RD Wallet. **221b**, another Cyberport incubatee, won the "FinTech (RegTech) Silver Award" for its AI/machine learning platform, 221b Watson, which employs big data analytics to process and visualise complex transaction patterns. **Propcap Technologies** won the "FinTech (Emerging Solutions) Bronze Award" for its digital green mortgage matched lending platform.

Cyberport has long been dedicated to promoting the digital entertainment industry and the Web3.0 ecosystem. This year, nine start-ups from the Cyberport community received a total of 11 awards in the "Digital Entertainment" category, including one Grand Award, three Gold Awards, three Silver Awards and one Bronze Award, in addition to the "Best Use of AI" award.

Aither Entertainment, with its upcoming game "Apeiron", won both the "Digital Entertainment Grand Award" and the "Digital Entertainment (Entertainment and Esports Software) Gold Award". Additionally, **Nikopicto**, a company specialising in computer animation, won the "Digital Entertainment (Computer Animation and Visual Effects) Gold Award" for a TV commercial produced for the European high-speed train OUIGO, with the design concept of low-carbon and low-cost travel in Spain. **Minidragon** secured the "Digital Entertainment (Entertainment and Esports Software) Silver Award" for its game "Hyper Dungeon". **KellyJohn Studio**, a game developer, earned the "Digital Entertainment (Interactive Design) Silver Award" with their digital entertainment sensory empowerment technology. **TELEPORT Immersive**, a company focused on providing immersive multimedia entertainment experiences, won the "Digital Entertainment (Interactive Design) Silver Award" thanks to their Mother's Day promotion campaign for the MTR, where participants could generate images and videos through an AI-driven "Magic Mirror". **Formula Square Holdings** earned the "Digital Entertainment (Entertainment and Esports Software) Bronze Award" for their 5G real virtuality (RV) racing experience.

Cyberport Start-ups Excel in Promoting Smart City Development to Benefit Society

With nearly 800 companies developing smart living and smart city technologies, the Cyberport community shone through across four categories, namely "Smart Living", "Smart Mobility", "Smart People" and "Smart Business" to garner a total of 11 awards including two Gold Awards, three Silver Awards and one Bronze Award, in addition to the "Best Use of AI" award mentioned above. **Maphive Technology**, a provider of innovative indoor navigation solutions, won the "Smart Mobility (Smart Tourism) Gold Award" for its smart city app

specialising in barrier-free navigation, CityGeni. **Locolla**, the only bike-sharing brand in Hong Kong, and **WiTricity HK**, a wireless charging technology company, jointly developed the world's first solar-powered, wirelessly charged micro mobile network to earn the "Smart Mobility (Smart Tourism) Silver Award". **SmartAge Intelligence** received the "Smart People (Smart Ageing) Silver Award" for its SmartAge Home System. Another Cyberport community member, **Laury & Co. Limited**, in collaboration with Pro-Act Training and Development Centre (Electrical) by the Vocational Training Council, achieved the "Smart Living (Smart Lifestyle) Silver Award" for their introduction of a VR training course for main switchboards. **OneAsia Network Limited** was awarded the "Business Solutions (Emerging Technologies) Bronze Award" for its Oasis Supercomputing Platform, which accelerates scientific research and data analysis using advanced IT infrastructure.

Cyberport Start-ups Shine in ICT Start-up and Student Innovation Categories

Five Cyberport community members: **Alpha AI Technology**, **GABES**, **R2C2**, **Legit App**, and **LifeSparrow Solutions** turned in outstanding performances in the "ICT Start-up" category. **Legit App** received the "ICT Start-up (Software and Apps) Silver Award" for the launch of Legit App, a revolutionary platform powered by AI technology for a fast and reliable authentication platform for luxury goods and sneakers. **R2C2** earned the "ICT Start-up (Hardware & Devices) Bronze Award" for its ARC automation inspection platform, a cutting-edge solution for property monitoring and security patrols. In the "Student Innovation" category, Cyberport start-up **PayPilot Group Limited**, representing the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, won the "Student Innovation (Higher Education) Bronze Award" for its innovative payment platform.

The Hong Kong ICT Awards is an annual signature event organised by the Digital Policy Office for the industry which aims to recognise and promote outstanding inventions and applications, thereby encouraging the pursuit of innovation and excellence among Hong Kong's ICT professionals and enterprises to develop innovative applications meeting business and social needs and use innovation and technology to bring benefits to the community. The winners may be nominated to compete in other regional and international competitions on behalf of Hong Kong and be sponsored to participate in overseas I&T exhibitions.
