Cyberport Community Shines Again at Hong Kong ICT Awards 2025 Claimed 21 Awards Across Six Key Categories

Hong Kong, 21 November 2025 – Cyberport community members achieved outstanding performance at the **Hong Kong ICT Awards 2025**, with 17 community companies collectively winning 21 awards. These included two Grand Awards, six Gold Awards, seven Silver Awards, two Bronze Awards, two Best Use of AI Awards, and two Certificate of Merit. The results highlight the Cyberport community’s innovation strengths across six major categories: FinTech, Information Technology, Smart Living, Digital Entertainment, Smart Business, and Smart Mobility. Notably, **MEGA Automation** captured three awards, while FinTech companies **Finloop** and **INF**, each secured two awards.

Ir Eric Chan, Chief Public Mission Officer of Cyberport, said, “The Hong Kong ICT Awards are widely recognised by the innovation and technology community. This year, many Cyberport community companies delivered outstanding performances, with several teams winning awards across multiple categories. This wins not only reflects the strong market recognition of their products and solutions, but also highlight Cyberport’s achievements in nurturing a vibrant I&T ecosystem. As Hong Kong’s digital tech hub and AI accelerator, we will continue to strengthen collaboration with industry partners, create more diverse real-world application scenarios for our community, and further accelerate the commercialisation of innovative ideas - all to strengthen Hong Kong’s position as an international I&T centre.”

MEGA Automation and Finloop Win Grand Awards

The award-winning companies stood out with breakthrough technologies and solutions. In the Smart Living category, **MEGA Automation** distinguished itself with its **Smart Hostel and Facility Management System**, developed on the CBOS cloud platform. The solutions earned three awards: the **Smart Living Grand Award**, the **Smart Living (Smart Home and Community) Gold Award**, and the **Smart Living Best Use of AI Award**. By integrating AI technologies and smart hardware, the system tackles key challenges in building management and deliver intelligent facility operations that significantly enhance efficiency and user experience.

Finloop excelled in the FinTech category with its **All-IN-ONE Virtual Asset (VA) Trading and RWA (Real World Asset) Solutions**, which won both the **FinTech Grand Award** and the **FinTech (Emerging Solutions: Virtual Assets, Payment, Blockchain and AI applications) Gold Award**. This one-stop “Web5” platform for real-world asset technology, issuance, and distribution integrates Web2 financial infrastructure with Web3 innovation to deliver institutional clients end-to-end support across technology, compliance, and market distribution, driving the advancement of the RWA sector.

INF also excelled in the FinTech category with its **Gen AI Investment Research and Sales Solution**, which earned the **FinTech Best Use of AI Award** and the **Fintech (Emerging Solutions: Virtual Assets, Payment, Blockchain and AI applications) Silver Award**. The solution leverages generative AI and INF's trusted large model to enhance productivity and efficiency in index customisation, investment research, and financial product sales.

Optimising Digital Asset Investment Decisions and Strengthening AML Management

Beyond these highlights, Cyberport community companies earned eight additional awards in the **FinTech category**. **Ola Protocol's** innovative investment analysis platform, **OLAXB**T, won the **FinTech (Banking, Investment, and Insurance) Gold Award**. **OLAXB**T builds on an AI-driven market ecosystem integrated with MCP to create a robust data layer that enables intelligent investment analysis. This data layer processes and delivers real-time market insights, including trend indices and signals from key opinion leaders, providing precise support for decision-making. Since its launch in March, the platform has rapidly amassed over 100,000 global users and provides institutional-grade solutions to numerous financial and digital asset trading institutions, forging deep strategic partnerships.

SlowMist's crypto asset tracking and compliance platform, **MistTrack**, won the **FinTech (RegTech: Regulatory and Risk Management) Gold Award**. Specialising in anti-money laundering (AML) and on-chain risk analysis, **MistTrack** leverages blockchain data to offer address risk scoring, label classification, transaction and temporal analysis, visualisation, real-time monitoring, and alerts. Supporting multiple mainstream public blockchains, the platform helps individual users, financial institutions, trading platforms, and compliance teams trace suspicious capital flows and strengthen compliance reviews and investigations.

Using IT to Safeguard Pet Health and Simplify Travel Preparation

Several Cyberport start-ups were recognised in the **ICT category**. **Decennium Platforms** won the **ICT Startup (Software and Apps) Gold Award** with its **Peqaboo - AI-integrated pet technology APP**. **Peqaboo's** proprietary AI gait analysis system can detect pet limping, joint issues, and track rehabilitation progress using short videos captured at home. The platform also integrates multimodal health monitoring, lab report interpretation, behaviour analysis, and intelligent recipe generation, offering comprehensive coverage from early detection to daily management for personalised pet healthcare.

Harvest Elite won the **Smart Mobility (Smart Tourism) Gold Award** for its smart travel system **Unlocking Opportunities in China**. The system connects hotels with group and individual travellers and integrates with super-app platforms. By applying big data analytics and machine learning, it effectively converts traffic into merchant revenue while offering innovative payment solutions that significantly reduce cross-border payment barriers.

Digital Entertainment Delivers Immersive Experiences with Hong Kong Cultural Elements

Three Cyberport startups excelled in the **Digital Entertainment category**. **MateZ Lab** won the **Digital Entertainment (Interaction Design) Silver Award** for its immersive interactive art space “**Panda Wonders**” attraction at **Hong Kong Ocean Park**. Using multi-projection fusion and interactive sensing, the project creates an immersive bamboo forest exploration, where visitors search for pandas hidden among flowers and bamboo, and take interactive AR photos with “Ying Ying” and the twin cubs “Jie Jie” and “De De,” enhancing the theme park’s interactive experience.

Organised by the Digital Policy Office, the Hong Kong ICT Awards is Hong Kong’s most prestigious ICT accolade. It aims to recognise and promote outstanding local ICT inventions and applications, encouraging continuous innovation and excellence across the industry. This year’s awardees will be nominated to participate in international competitions to expand their global reach.
