Hong Kong's First Dedicated Hub for One-Person Companies "OPC Hub @ Cyberport " Launched and Web 4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance Established

Lowering Barriers to Entrepreneurship, Unlocking Greater Economic Value

Hong Kong, 13 July 2026 – As a key anchor and pioneer in Web4.0 development, Cyberport is committed to positioning Hong Kong as a global Web4.0 hub. The inaugural Web4.0 & Agentic AI Innovation Summit, organised by Cyberport in conjunction with the OPC Hub @ Cyberport Launch Ceremony, concluded successfully today.

At the event, Cyberport officially launched OPC Hub @ Cyberport, Hong Kong's first dedicated innovation and entrepreneurship platform for One-Person Companies (OPCs). Cyberport also announced the establishment of the Web4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance, marking a new chapter for trusted Web4.0 development and AI agent adoption within Hong Kong's innovation and technology ecosystem.

The Summit brought together industry leaders, next-generation entrepreneurs, and representatives of the innovation and technology ecosystem to explore how the Agentic AI era is reshaping business productivity, entrepreneurial models, and organisational structures.

OPC Hub @ Cyberport was launched in response to the rapid evolution and widespread adoption of AI agents and agentic AI technologies, as well as the emergence of supporting tools and platforms. As AI capabilities continue to advance, individual entrepreneurs can increasingly overcome traditional resource and scale constraints, transforming innovative ideas, professional expertise and industry insights into impactful products and services. Tasks that once required a team or multiple departments including research and analysis, customer service, marketing and operations management, can now be performed more efficiently with AI agents and AI tools, offering a more flexible and cost-effective path to growth for a new generation of entrepreneurs.

We have therefore established the Web4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance. Together with industry leaders including Alibaba Cloud, AWS, BytePlus, Cobo, Dell Technologies, FizzDragon, iFLYTEK, Lenovo, and NVIDIA, we will advance practical industry frameworks, best practices and secure application demonstrations to foster the trusted development of Agentic AI. Cyberport will

continue to serve as a core hub for Web4.0 development, connecting innovative talent, technology, capital and industry resources to drive the implementation of more AI agent innovations and entrepreneurial projects, and support Hong Kong's development as a global hub for Web4.0 innovation and entrepreneurship.”

OPC Hub @ Cyberport provides a one-stop AI support

To address the development needs of One-Person-Companies, OPC Hub @ Cyberport draws on Cyberport's community and networks to provide eligible OPC members with one-stop support. This includes co-working space, AI inference and computing resources, model usage credits, cloud services, training and networking, marketing and showcasing opportunities, investor matching, industry connections, and cybersecurity support for Agentic AI, AI agents, and blockchain-related applications. These resources enable entrepreneurs and small teams that make extensive use of AI, to undertake product development, operations and business expansion more efficiently.

OPC Hub @ Cyberport welcomes applications from entrepreneurs in Hong Kong and around the world. Applicants must be Hong Kong-incorporated companies established for no more than two years and need not be existing Cyberport members. They must, however, demonstrate that their businesses are strongly related to AI agents, such as by developing industry-specific AI agent solutions, integrating AI agents with blockchain or financial infrastructure, or providing tools and technologies that support the broader AI ecosystem.

Web4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance established to build an AI safety net

To address emerging cybersecurity risks in the Web4.0 era, particularly those arising from the development of Agentic AI and blockchain, Cyberport has also established the Web4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance (the Alliance). The Alliance was inaugurated today, brings together industry leaders as founding members, including 360 Digital Security Group, Beosin, BlockSec, CertiK, DAS-Security, FORMS HK, Integrity Technology Group, Hillstone Networks, NyxLab, QingTeng Cloud Security, Sangfor Technologies, and SlowMist, with the Hong Kong Cybersecurity Professionals Association serving as the Alliance Advisor.

The Alliance aims to foster a trusted Web4.0 and agentic AI ecosystem and accelerate trusted adoption. Its work will focus on four objectives: promoting cross-industry collaboration to address security challenges; advancing practical security principles best practices, and industry framework guidelines; establishing a repository of demonstrations and real-world use case; and encouraging broader ecosystem participation.

Cyberport is Hong Kong's digital technology hub and AI accelerator, bringing together more than 500 start-ups and technology companies specialising in AI and big data research and development (R&D), more than 310 blockchain and digital asset companies, and over 30 cybersecurity technology companies, forming a robust and secure AI ecosystem. Web4.0 can be understood as an “agentic and programmable internet” that brings together Agentic

AI and Web3.0 capabilities. As an important direction for the next-generation of the digital economy, Web4.0 enables autonomous execution, intelligent collaboration and programmable value exchange, further advancing the convergence of AI, blockchain, and digital asset applications. With the establishment of OPC Hub @ Cyberport and the Web4.0 & Agentic AI Security Alliance, Cyberport will further deepen the integration of AI, blockchain and cybersecurity, translating the strengths of its ecosystem into targeted support for OPCs, helping shape Hong Kong's next-generation digital future and supporting its development as a global Web4.0 hub.
